UlW I'm a Cardinal! What's Next for Transfer Students?



1. Apply For Financial Aid (FAFSA/TASFA)

Apply for financial aid beginning in December to qualify for state, federal and university grants. Apply online at bit.ly/UIWFAFSA. **UIW's FAFSA code is 003578.**

2. Confirm Your Attendance

Meet with your admissions counselor to review your financial aid package. When ready, pay your \$100 confirmation fee at uiw.edu/confirm (not required for part-time and non-degree-seeking students).

3. Submit Proof of Bacterial Meningitis Vaccination

Texas state law mandates that all students under the age of 22 entering a Texas college or university provide documentation that they received a bacterial meningitis vaccination within five years preceding their first day of class. You may submit your vaccination record in PDF form to the Office of the Registrar at registrar@uiwtx.edu.

4. Sign Up for On-Campus Housing (Optional)

Housing is available if you wish to live on campus. View available residence halls and apply online at uiw.edu/housing. This option requires a \$225 deposit.

5. Prepare for Class Registration and Orientation

Within a few days of confirming your attendance, you'll receive your UIW credentials. Check your UIW email for information on orientation and class registration. Your advisor will also email you information regarding course registration for your first semester. Visit uiw.edu/orientation for updates.

6. Submit Final Official Documents

Submit official transcripts from each institution where you've been enrolled. If you have fewer than 24 college credit hours post high school, you are also required to submit an official high school transcript with your graduation date or GED scores. - Where can I find my student ID number?
