TEXAS EQUALIZATION GRANT (TEG) FOR TEXAS RESIDENTS

Texas residents, who are eligible to domicile in the United States, with financial need may be eligible for TEG up to \$3,300 annually. TEG may be renewed if the recipient maintains a cumulative 2.5+ GPA and completes at least 24 credit hours per academic year with a minimum completion rate of 75%. To determine eligibility, Texas residents must submit the Texas Application for State Financial Aid (TASFA) to the Office of Financial Assistance.

PAYMENT PLAN

The UIW Business Office offers students a Tuition Payment Plan which allows students to divide their balance into installments each semester. Enrollment into this plan may include an enrollment fee.
